Stephen H. Hoffman, President and Chief Executive Officer of United Jewish Communities, is a graduate of Dickinson College and received his MSW from the University of Maryland and a Master's in Jewish studies from the Baltimore Hebrew University. He is also a graduate of the Council of Jewish Federation's executive recruitment and education program (FEREP).

He began his career at the Jewish Community Federation of Cleveland in 1974, and served as director of social planning and research and assistant director, before becoming president. He is the founding director of the Council for Initiatives in Jewish Education and serves on the Visiting Committee of the Mandel School of Applied Social Sciences at Case Western Reserve University.

He is a board member of the Musical Arts Association (the Cleveland Orchestra), the Mandel Foundation and the David and Inez Myers Foundation. He is a past board member of the Greater Cleveland Roundtable, an organization devoted to promoting racial harmony in the city of Cleveland. In May of 2002, he was awarded a Doctor of Humane Letters from the Baltimore Hebrew University, and in March of 2003, he was the first recipient of the Fuchs Mizrahi School's Guardian of Zion Award in Cleveland, Ohio.
