Ruth Wedgwood - Chair of the ASIL Studies Committee; Professor, Yale Law School; Professor of International Law and Diplomacy and Director of International Law and Organization, Johns Hopkins University School of Advanced International Studies; Senior Fellow for International Organizations and Law at the Council on Foreign Relations; expert in international criminal law, armed conflict, use of force, UN policy, peacekeeping, human rights, public international law generally.

A former prosecutor and clerk to Justice Blackmun, Professor Wedgwood has been concentrating most recently on international law and national security. She is widely published in the fields of public international law, the use of force and war crimes, human rights, United Nations studies and international arbitration. She has conducted research on international law and policy problems arising at the United Nations and on regional peacekeeping operations and civil reconstruction efforts in Haiti, Bosnia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Georgia and East Timor. Professor Wedgwood is also a Fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations.
